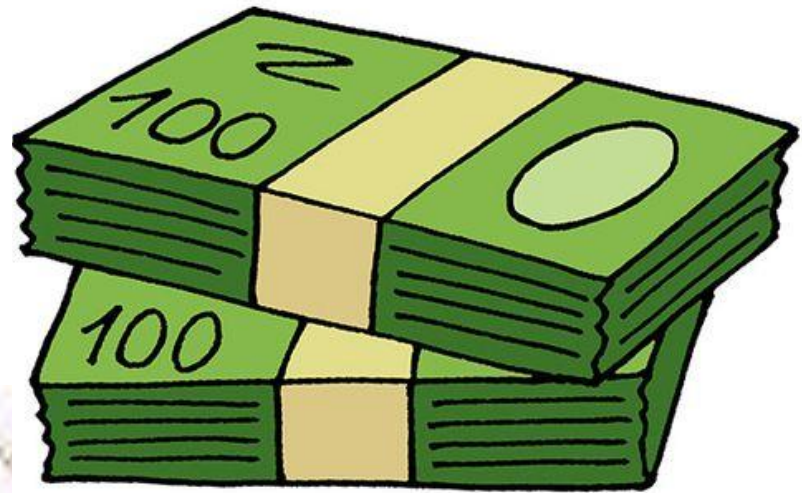


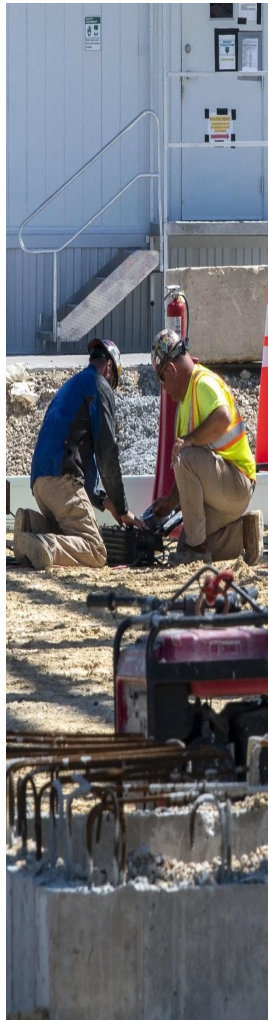

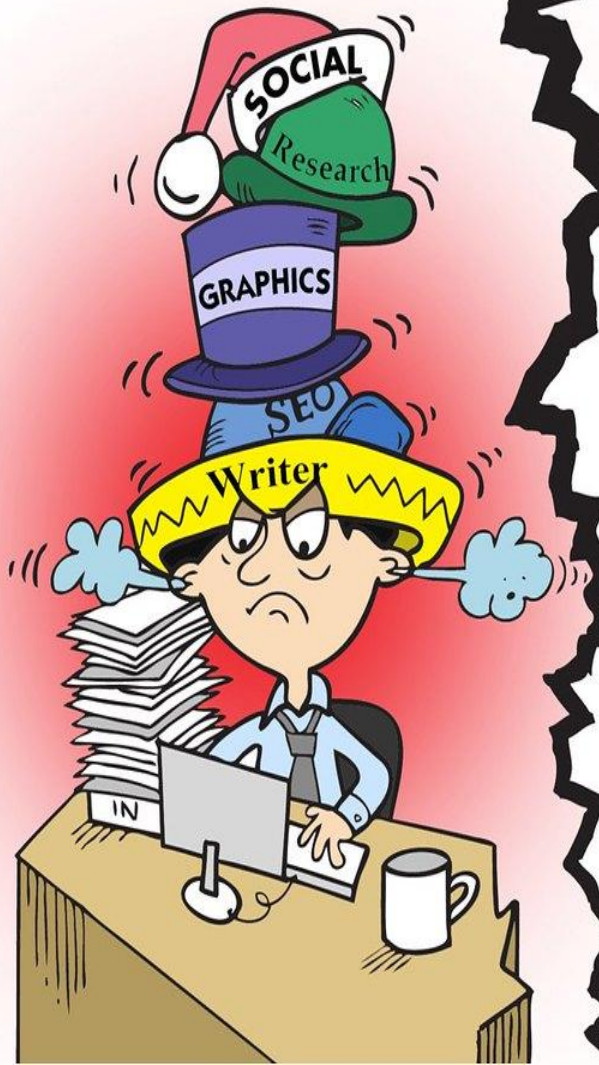

1. Creating the concept
2. Writing a script / outline (optional)
3. Pre-production planning
4. Shooting the video
5. Edit the video
6. Finalizing video
7. Video distribution

# Creating the concept and making video outline

Concept:

Outline:

I will sit in my car and eat the food and give my opinion right after.

Concept:

Doing the latest trending dance and sound.

Outline:

I will clear the living room floor and dance.

# Pre-production planning questions

## **How will this be recorded?**

iPhone, mom's tablet, borrow cousin's camera.

## **How will the music be put in the video?**

Use the software built into the TikTok app that adds in the music.

## **How is the iPhone going to record me?**

Purchase a tripod. Stack a bunch of books and lay it against the wall.

Will my phone hear me talk?

What's the angle of the camera?

Is my living room too dark to see anything I'm doing?

Will there be anyone else bugging me during the recording?

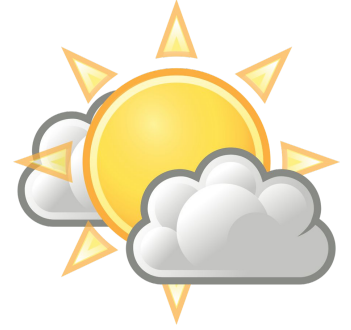

# What is Stage Fright?

Stage fright is a type of anxiety that describes feeling anxious when speaking or performing in front of a group of people. It isn't just limited to literal stages. In general, stage fright is a colloquial term used to describe performance anxiety, presentation anxiety, or the fear of public speaking.



# How to Get Over Stage Fright

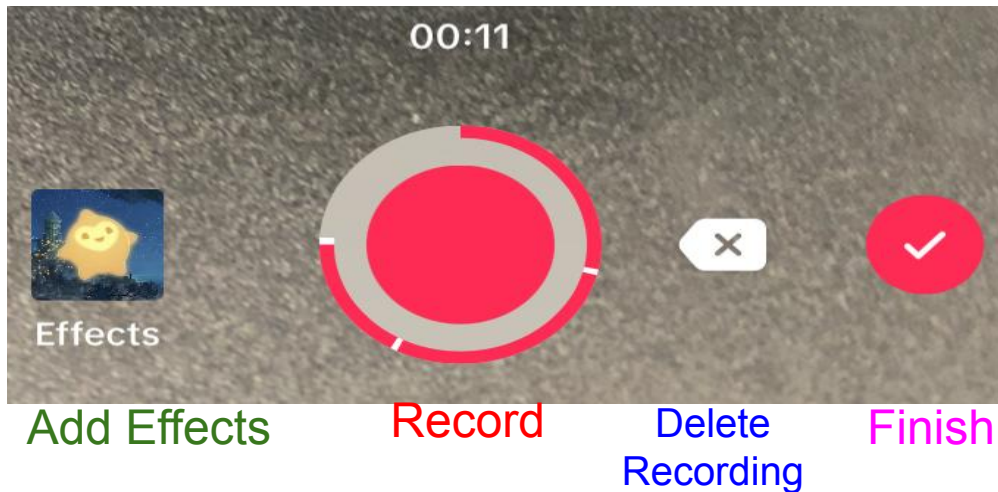
1. See a therapist
2. Practice beforehand
3. Tell yourself a positive mantra
4. Practice positive visualization
5. Engage in deep breathing
6. Avoid or limit caffeine and other mood-altering substances
7. Focus on your material
8. Stick with what works (and what you know)
9. Expose yourself to speaking situations often
10. Reassess after your presentation



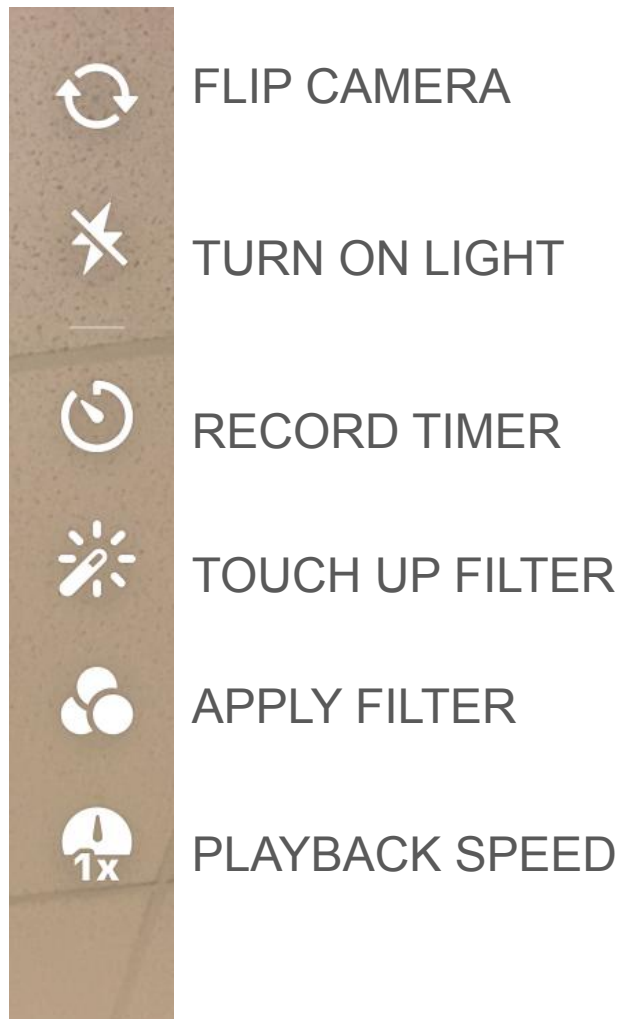

# Recording Screen



You can record multiple times.  
Each recording is split by a white line.





**Settings:** Modify who can view, comment permissions, and other permissions.



**Download:** Download video to local device.

Edit



**Edit:** Modify clip, add more clips, add photos, and sound.

Templates



**Templates:** Pre-made filters and effects

Text



**Text:** Insert above the video and can add Text-to-speech

Stickers



**Stickers:** Emojis over the video

Effects



**Effects:** transitions and time manipulation

Filters



**Filters:** Changes colors and tones.

Add Yours



**Add Yours:** Allows you to interact with others on TikTok through a prompt that you can add to your video or respond to.

Voice

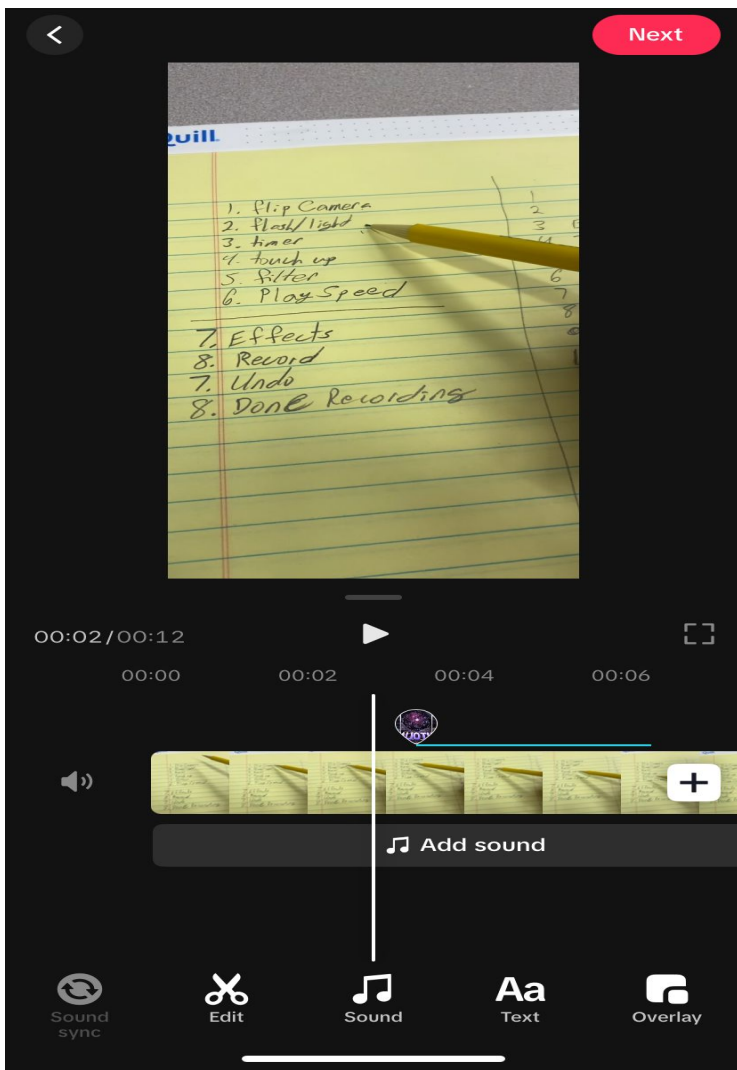


**Voice:** Autotune or voice modify

Captions



**Captions:** Small automated text on the screen based on the current video audio.

**Next:** Finish Edits

**Edit:** Modify the current clip / element

**Sound:** Add Sound

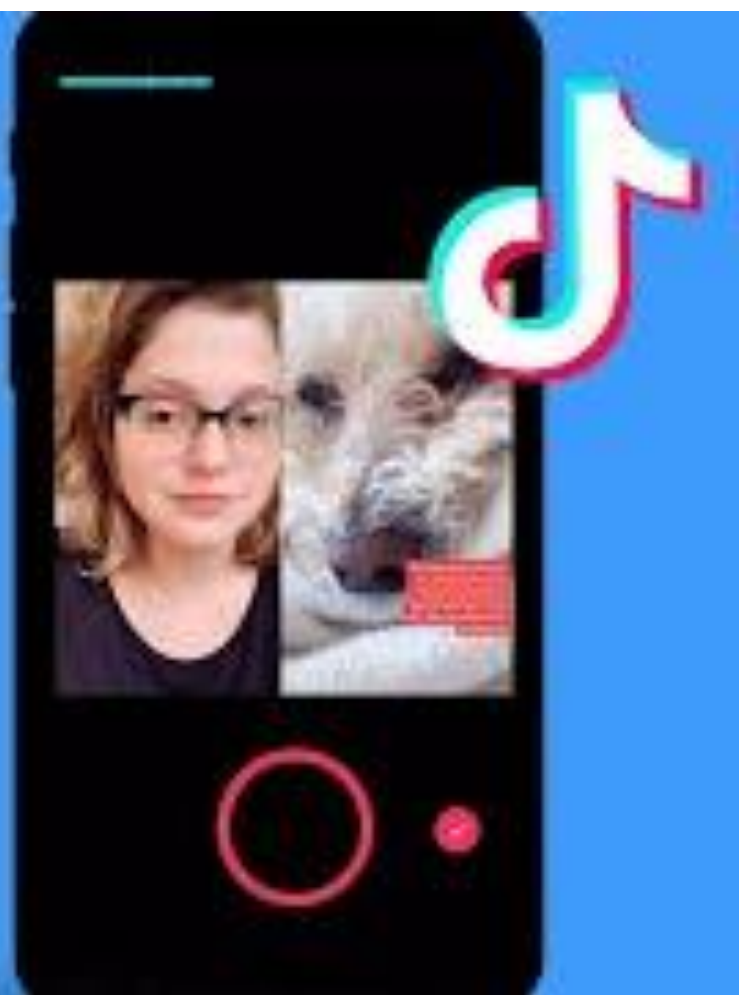
**Text:** Add Text

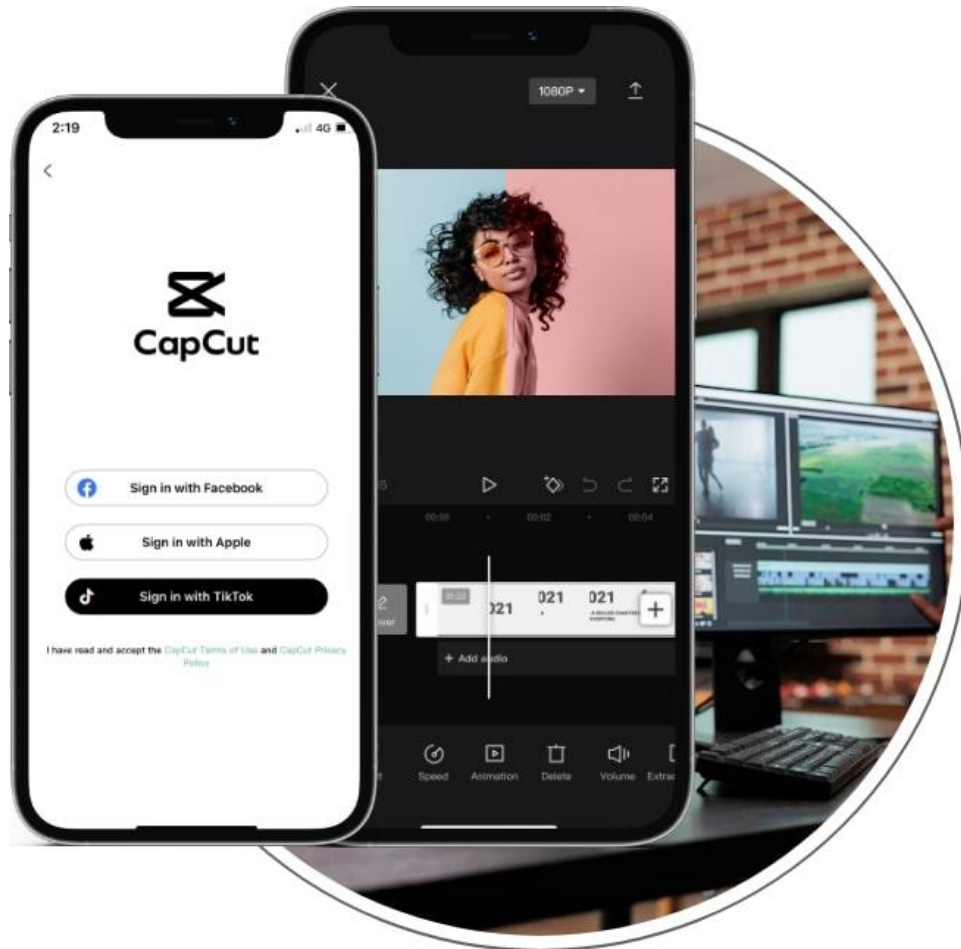

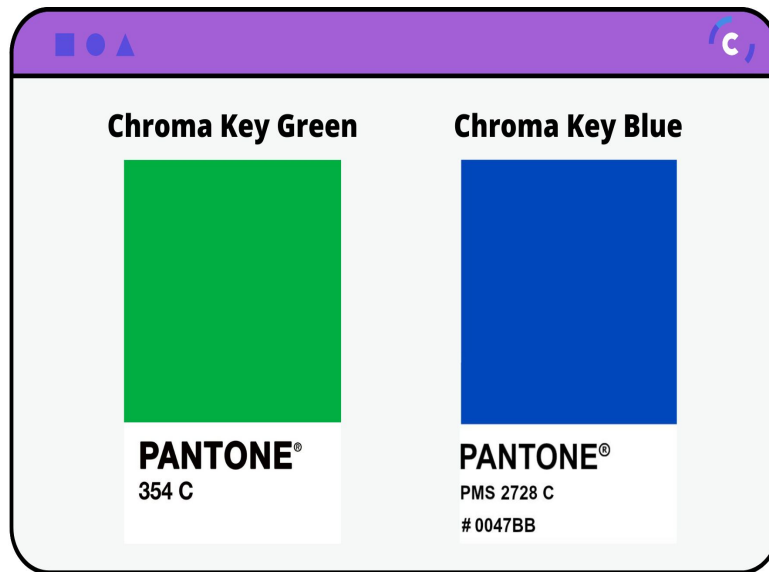
