





Optimize Charging Habits:

Avoid Overcharging:

While modern tablets often have protection against overcharging, it's still best to avoid keeping the tablet plugged in for extended periods after it's fully charged.

Charge to 80%:

Ideally, charge your tablet to around 80% and avoid letting it drain completely, as this can put strain on the battery.

Avoid Extreme Temperatures:

Keep your tablet in a cool, dry environment, as extreme temperatures can negatively impact battery performance and lifespan.

Consider Smart Charging:

Some tablets offer smart charging features that can optimize the charging process and extend battery life.


Other Tips:

- Keep Software Updated: Software updates often include battery optimization improvements.
- Store Half-Charged: If storing for a long period, store the tablet with a 50% charge.
- Power Down When Not in Use: Turning off the tablet completely can prevent unnecessary battery drain.

- Setting up a Google account
 - (importance for Play Store).

- Setting up a Samsung account (benefits).
- Lock screen options
 - Lock screen options
 (pin number, fingerprint, facial recognition).



Recents:

The button to the far left. When you tap this, your recently opened apps will appear.

Home:

The button in the very center. Tap this to be taken to the Home screen.

Back:

The button to the far right.

Tap this to go back to the previous screen.




