What Is a Website?

- Accessed through an internet browser
 - Chrome, Safari, Edge
- You type an address
 - www.alpl.org
 - shop.recess.games
 - www.msn.com
 - whitehouse.gov
- Works on any device

Examples:

- News sites
- Government services
- Online encyclopedias



What Is an App?

- Installed on phones or tablets
- Designed for quick, repeated use
- Often easier buttons and notifications



Why Apps Are Popular with Seniors

- Larger buttons
- Fewer steps
- Saved logins
- Designed for touch screens





iPhone, iPad, and Apple PCs.

Can only download & install apps that are approved from the App Store.



Google Play

Android devices, Samsung, Chromebook, and Sony devices.

Can download apps from their own brand app store & the Google Play.

Requires a Google account to download the apps.

Website	App
No additional installation	Installed on device
Access to all sites & features	Only one company's site & features
More complex options	Simple and simplified layout

Safety Tip

- Download apps only from official app stores
- Be cautious of pop-ups asking for personal info

What Is a QR Code?

A QR code is a square-shaped picture made of black-and-white patterns. It works like a shortcut: when you scan it with a phone or tablet camera, it instantly opens information—no typing needed.

How to Scan a QR Code

1. Open your phone's camera
2. Point it at the QR code
3. A message appears
4. Tap the message to open



No app is usually needed on modern phones.

Safety Tips for QR Codes

Only scan QR codes from trusted places

Be cautious of QR codes:

- On random signs
- On emails from strangers

Never enter:

- Bank passwords
- Social Security numbers
- Personal information unless you trust the source


A QR code itself is not dangerous—but where it takes you can be.

Medical and Health Uses

- Check-in forms
- Appointment details

Pharmacies use them for:

- Prescription info
- Instructions
- Benefit
- Less paperwork
- Faster check-ins
- Easy access to health information



Menus and Restaurants

- Restaurants use QR codes instead of printed menus
- Scan the code → menu appears on your phone

Useful for:

1. Cleanliness
2. Easy updates
3. Large, zoomable text

Public Places and Transportation


QR codes are used for:

- Train and bus tickets
- Event tickets
- Museum information
- Park signs

What Are Messaging Apps?

- Texting, but over the internet
- Can send:
 - Text
 - Photos
 - Voice messages
 - Videos

How They Differ from Text Messages

- Work internationally
- Use Wi-Fi instead of phone plans
- Allow group conversations

Common Uses

- Family group chats
- Sending pictures instantly
- Quick check-ins

Why Seniors Like Them

- Faster than email
- More personal
- Video calls allow body language and lip reading.

Video Call Negatives:

1. Being conscious about your appearance and surroundings.
2. Not everyone is comfortable with a video call so text or call before the video call.
3. Having to hold or position the phone camera properly.

Best Apps by Category

- **Privacy & Security:**
 - **Signal:** Widely considered the gold standard for security, offering default end-to-end encryption for all texts, voice, and video calls with minimal data collection.
 - **Threema:** A paid alternative that allows users to chat anonymously without linking a phone number or email.
- **Standard Phone Integration:**
 - [Google Messages](#): The default on most Android devices, now featuring RCS for high-resolution media sharing between Android and iPhone.
 - **iMessage:** Apple's native messaging service, integrated into all iOS devices.


- **Workplace & Professional:**

- **Slack:** Best for extensive third-party app integrations and channel-based organization.
- **Microsoft Teams:** The standard for businesses already using Microsoft 365.
- **Google Chat:** A streamlined option for Google Workspace users.

Almost the whole day None/Don't know



Most Popular Types of Videos on the Internet (2023)




VIDEO IS KING

Key reasons video reigns supreme:

- Higher Retention: People remember significantly more from videos (95%) than text (10%) because it uses both sight and sound.
- Stronger Engagement: Video captures attention quickly and keeps it longer, with high sharing and interaction rates.
- Complex Ideas Simplified: It's easier to understand processes, products, or services when shown in action.
- Emotional Connection: Visuals and audio build trust and foster deeper connections with brands and stories.
- Better SEO: Search engines favor websites with video, boosting organic traffic and visibility.
- Mobile-Friendly: Video is perfectly suited for on-the-go consumption via mobile devices.
